Roles

1. Film Project Manager

Primary Responsibilities

- Prepare and coordinate Content/Story film budgets specific to assigned projects
- Oversee preliminary search and survey of all locations and the completion of business arrangements for those locations
- Coordinate arrangements for the transportation and housing of cast, crew and staff as well as transport of equipment
- 4. Oversee the securing of releases and negotiate locations and personnel.
- 5. Maintain a liaison with local authorities regarding locations and the operation of the company
- 6. Hire all crew and schedule all gear rentals as well as handle invoicing for crew and gear
- Track all deadlines and projects related to film projects
- 8. Schedule project specific meetings with Programming/Story
- Assertive in continuing education while at CIY and away from CIY (blogs, articles, video tutorials, seminars, etc)
